**NOTICE OF RACE**

**1 RULES**

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 No national authority prescriptions will apply.
- 1.3 If there is a conflict between the Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions then the Sailing Instructions shall prevail
- 1.4 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

**2 ADVERTISING**

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

**3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

The regatta is open to all boats of the B14 classes.

#### **6 MEASUREMENTS**

Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate if requested.

#### **7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

The sailing instructions will be available on the class web site and at [www.mayflowersc.org.uk](http://www.mayflowersc.org.uk) on the forms and documents page.

#### **8 THE COURSES**

The courses to be sailed will be windward/leeward courses.

#### **9 PENALTY SYSTEM**

The Scoring Penalty, rule 44.3, will not apply.

#### **10 SCORING**

The low point scoring system shall apply.

#### **11 SUPPORT BOATS**

Support boats shall not be near the course after the 1<sup>st</sup> warning signal of the day.

#### **12 BERTHING**

Boats shall be kept in the boat park opposite the Mayflower Sailing Club.

#### **13 PRIZES**

Prizes will be awarded dependent on the number of entries.

**14 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

**15 INSURANCE**

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £2'000'000 per boat.
